We are having another Zoom meeting in July. The COVID-19 statistics are still unsettling nationwide, even though they're not as alarming in this region. Many thanks to Jane Macke for updating the excel directory and the picture directory. She also did most of the work on the 2020-2021 budget. She is serving her <u>third</u> term as club Treasurer. There should be a medal for that.

The proposed annual budget is on this month's agenda. The club needs to review and vote on it. You will receive a copy before the meeting. A page full of numbers is not the easiest thing to understand. Some numbers to note are projected fundraising under income and proposed scholarship awards under service fund expenses. We do have carryover dollars in the service fund from the 2019-2020 year.

Our general fund income is based on 25 members, though, so it is hoped we'll add two new members (at least) during the year.
